Postdoctoral Certificate of Training

We now have a postdoctoral certificate of training available to provide to our postdocs as verification of their time spent here at the University of Pittsburgh. The certificate includes their supervisor, department/division/institute and dates they were appointed as a postdoc. Signed by Dr. Darlene Zellers, Associate Dean for Postdoctoral Affairs and the Professor/Chair of the department, this certificate can be used as proof of their postdoctoral research position.

This includes but is not limited to: appointment dates, funding source(s), and salary. The database must be updated to correctly reflect all aspects of the offer.

When submitting a voluntary or involuntary termination in Pitt Worx, please remember to also submit the termination request in the OACD Postdoctoral Database Portal. We are

collecting career outcomes on our postdocs; therefore, if you know where the terminating postdoc is going (e.g., university/company and employment details), please enter the information under termination details. If you do not know where the postdoc is going, please enter "Unknown" for all fields. **Do not enter their current position information.**
